	<p>Your Discovery Rangers flight will lift you to new heights; earning your Gold Falcon; Gold Hawk; and soaring to your Gold Eagle.</p> <p>Each of these three annual flight paths (Falcon, Hawk, and Eagle) has four intermediate steps (White, Red, Bronze, Silver) leading to the Gold for each advancement flight.</p> <p>Earning your Gold Eagle will provide an opportunity for you to earn your Gold Medal of Achievement in Adventure Rangers.</p> <p>The basic requirements to earn the Gold Eagle include: Leadership, Skill, and Bible merits; with leadership responsibilities. Also, memorize Royal Rangers Pledge, Code, Motto, points of the Emblem, & the Golden Rule.</p>


